The precepts of the Lord are _____ Effect—Rejoicing the heart

The commandment of the Lord is _____ Effect—Enlightening the eyes

The fear of the Lord is _____ Effect—They endure forever

The judgments of the Lord are _____ Effect—They are righteous altogether

For David, God's Word was more desirable than anything this life could produce, more desirable than _____ and sweeter than _____. (vs. 10)

*They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold;
Sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb.*
